



## HALO TREATMENT FAQ'S

### WHAT IS HALO?

Halo is a revolutionary laser treatment and is the ONLY treatment that uses two lasers at the same time. This means that multiple layers of skin are being treated simultaneously. Why is this such a big deal? We know you want results with fewer treatments, and most likely you are too busy to have a week or more of downtime.

In just a few treatments, you will be reunited with the skin of your youth. You will still be the same lovely you, but with less sun damage, fewer fine lines, smaller appearing pores and better overall texture. To sum it all up, you will have the coveted "Halo glow"! You can expect three to four days of downtime, but that may vary depending on the level of your customized treatment.

### HOW MANY TREATMENTS WILL I NEED?

Every patient is different. You can choose to have one or two more aggressive treatments or have multiple treatments that are less aggressive and achieve a similar goal over a longer period of time.

### WHAT HAPPENS DURING THE TREATMENT?

Prior to your treatment, a topical anesthetic will be applied to your skin to reduce the sensation during the procedure. The area will be measured with motion tracking. The physician will treat each measured section by uniformly rolling the Halo hand-piece over the skin. Typical Treatment Time (1 area): 1 hour.

### WHAT DOES HALO FEEL LIKE?

With a topical anesthetic and integrated cooling technology, most patients experience very little discomfort. Most patients describe the treatment as a feeling of heat with occasional prickling sensations. After the treatment, most patients will continue to feel warm for an additional 15 to 30 minutes, or a bit longer with deeper treatment levels.

### HOW WILL I CARE FOR MY SKIN AFTER MY TREATMENT?

Your medical grade, post-procedure regimen is included in the cost of your treatment. You will pick this up in LABL Studio after you have paid your \$300 deposit. Written and verbal instructions will be provided when you pick up your kit.



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### HOW CAN I PREPARE MY SKIN FOR OPTIMAL RESULTS?

We highly recommend starting Alastin Skin Nectar two weeks before your treatment. This proprietary formulation helps to clear damage and debris before your treatment, allowing your skin to receive the maximum benefits. (Like weeding your garden before planting your seeds!) Continue use immediately post-procedure and twice daily throughout the healing process for faster recovery. Available in our skincare boutique.

### HOW SOON AFTER MY TREATMENT CAN I RETURN TO NORMAL ACTIVITIES?

First 24 hours: You should keep your skin protected according to our post-procedure instructions.  
24 - 48 Hours: You may experience moderate swelling .  
Days 2 - 3: You will develop a light bronzing appearance.  
Day 3 - 5: Your skin will peel, revealing your new skin beneath.

### WHEN WILL I SEE RESULTS?

You will see initial results between five to seven days after your Halo treatment, but your skin will continue to improve over time. Most patients see the greatest pigmentary improvement in the first two to three weeks. This is followed by a dermal regeneration phase that continues to improve for months.

### HOW LONG WILL MY RESULTS LAST?

Your Halo results will last for years to come, but you should continue to keep your skin protected at all times using UV sunscreen to protect your new, healthy skin. Each additional Halo treatment will only improve your results, giving you even better-looking skin. A good skincare regimen is key to protecting your investment.
